#### NOTICE OF CLASS ACTION TO NEWLY IDENTIFIED INVESTORS

#### **Description of the Proceedings**

On June 2, 2005, an action was commenced against the Defendants surrounding the operation of an investment scheme commonly known as "HMS". It is alleged that the HMS investment scheme was not a legitimate investment activity and in fact constituted an illegal fraudulent "pyramid" or "Ponzi" scheme.

This action is a class action brought on behalf of investors in the HMS investment scheme (the "HMS Scheme") who have suffered losses. We are co-counsel to the Plaintiff Class in this class action.

The Representative Plaintiffs for the Class, Douglas Alexander of Calgary, Alberta and William Barrett of Santa Fe, New Mexico, allege that the illegal Ponzi scheme was operated by HMS Financial Inc. ("HMS") and the other Defendants, and that this illegal Ponzi scheme caused losses to persons who invested of approximately \$100,000,000.00. Accordingly the Representative Plaintiffs, on behalf of all investors in HMS, other than the Defendants, claim damages against the Defendants in the amount of \$100,000,000.00.

We recently received new information from various Defendants about investors not known to us through the records that were previously available to us. This new information alerted us that you invested with HMS or other Defendants and are, therefore, potentially a class member.

#### Class Definition and Opting In or Out of the Class

Class Members include all persons, other than the Defendants, who are residents of Alberta and have invested money with the HMS Scheme, directly or indirectly, and suffered a loss of all or a part of that investment. If you are an Alberta resident you are automatically a class member unless you choose to "opt out", the deadline for which was August 14, 2009.

However, you are free to make an application to the Court to now opt out. If you do choose to apply to opt out of this Class Action, you must provide our office with copies of your application materials, which must have been previously filed with the Court, by July 30, 2011.

#### NOTICE OF CLASS ACTION TO NEWLY IDENTIFIED INVESTORS

Non-resident Albertans are required to "opt in" to the Class, and the deadline for doing so was August 14, 2009. We are, however, keeping a list of Late Opt-Ins and intend to apply to the Court to have any Late Opt-Ins added to the Class. In order to make this application as soon as possible, if you are a non-resident and wish to opt in please provide us with your completed form (attached to this Notice or by filling out the electronic online form which can be accessed at http://www.mross.com/law/HMS Claims) by July 30, 2011.

If you become a member of the Class (either as an Alberta resident who does not opt-out or as a non-Alberta resident who is added to the list of Late Opt-Ins and later added to the class), you will be bound by the determination of the common issues as decided by the Court, whether reached by settlement or otherwise, favorable or not. Class members who opt out of the Class will not benefit from any successful judgment or settlement.

It is ultimately up to the Court to decide if you will be allowed to opt in or opt out of the Class at this time.

#### **Legal Fees and Disbursements**

This matter is being pursued by Class Co-Counsel on a contingency fee basis, which means that you do not have to pay any money up front to have us act on your behalf. We get paid only if we recover funds on your behalf, in which case our Contingency Fee Agreement with the Representative Plaintiffs allows us to retain 33.33% plus disbursements on any recovery, before a distribution is made to Class Members. This fee is subject to Court approval, and pursuant to Section 39 of the *Class Proceedings Act*, class members do have the option to object to the Court at the time of the approval of such fees. The Court has already issued Orders approving our contingent fee arrangement and payment to us in the context of some specific, limited early payments to Class members with "directly traceable" claims to specific funds seized as part of the HMS Scheme.
